**The SPIN is an evening event which starts at 5 o'clock and officially finishes at 8 o'clock, but has an open end for discussions.**

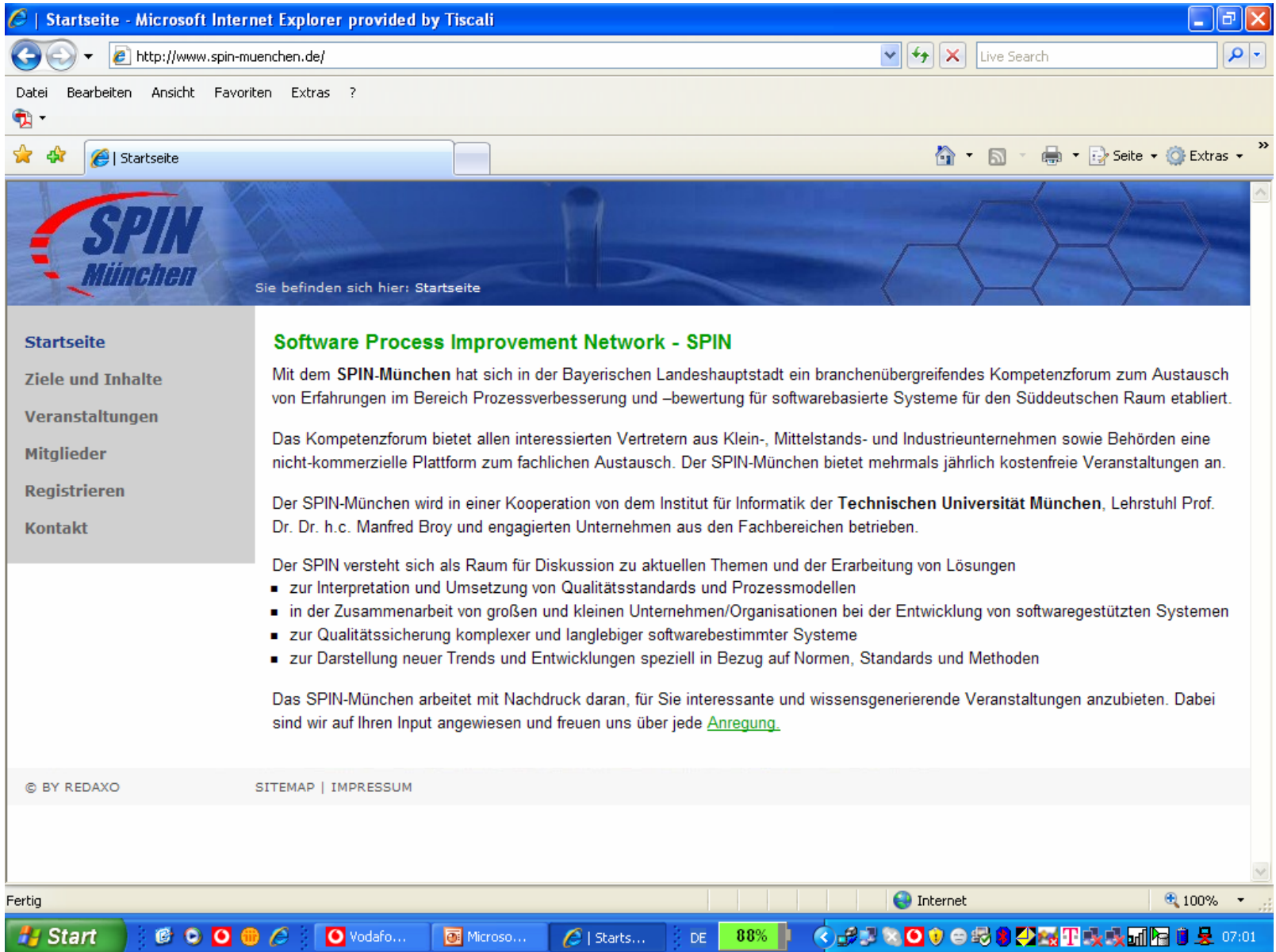
**We always distribute an agenda and have feedback templates for the attendants to improve on the organization and find out about the topics the members want to have adressed.**
